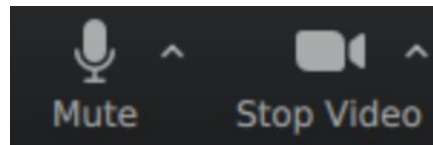

Technology — Zoom

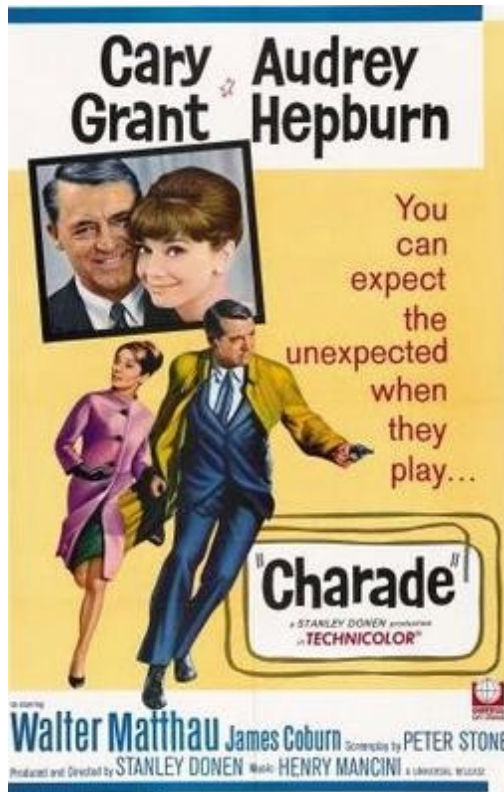
- Zoom allows a movie to be shared
